### Post-discharge

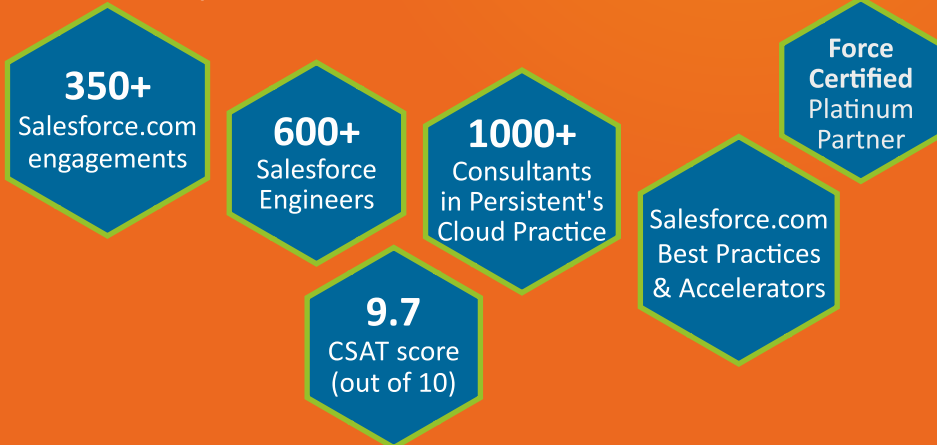
